## KEY TRENDS

- + Nine **Safety Car** deployments in the last nine races.
- + Six of the last nine races have seen the **Safety Car** deployed.
- + The driver on **Pole** has only taken the race victory in 33.33% of the races.
- + ...and has only set the **Fastest Lap** on three occasions too.
- + **Wet tyres** have been required in four of the last nine races.
- + **Kimi Raikkonen** has won the last three races here, but only from pole position once.
- + The average **Lap of First Retirement** is well below the 2008 season average.
